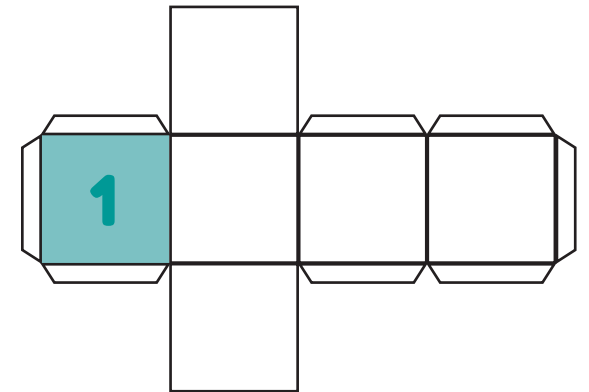




## COUNTING TILL 5!

Santiago says: "And I've got one mouth."

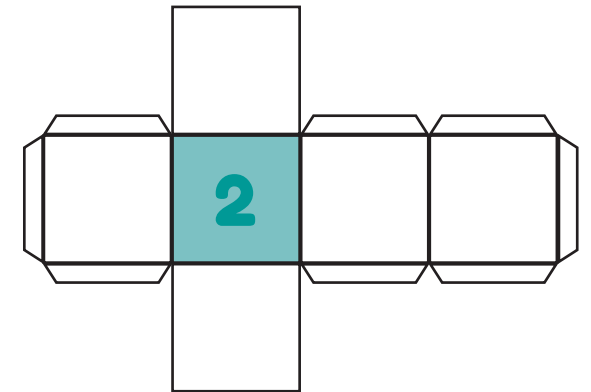




2. Sol says: “And I've got two eyes:  
one and two.”

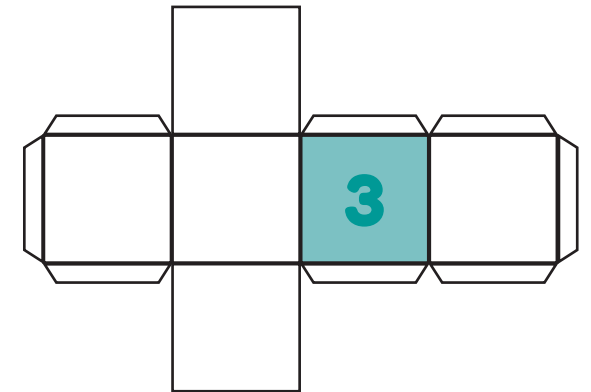
Santiago says: “And I've got two ears,

face in English.”





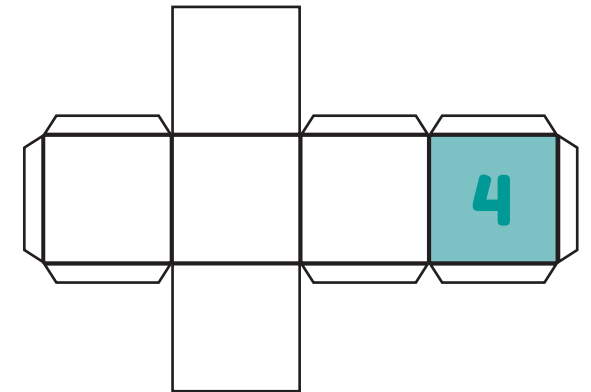
3. “Look Sol”, Santiago says: “I’ve got two feet. One, two.”

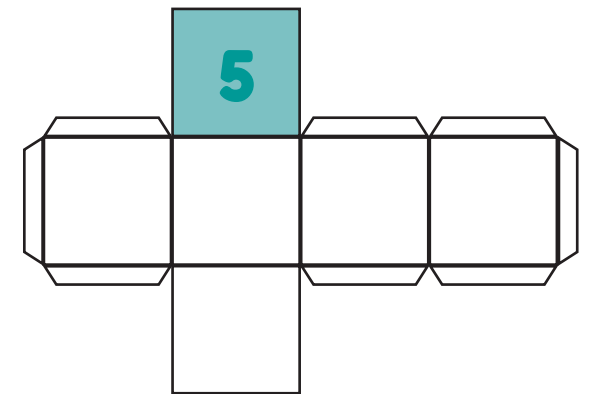


4. Sol says: "Cinamon come in!.

6. Then Sol says: “Look Santiago! I've got fingers in my hand.”

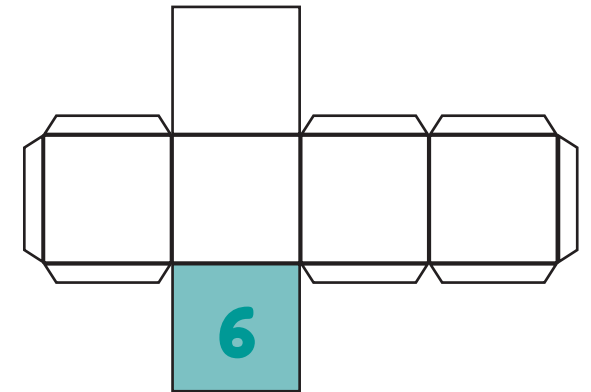
Santiago asks: “How many fingers...?”

Santiago says: “Thank you Jesus for my body!”



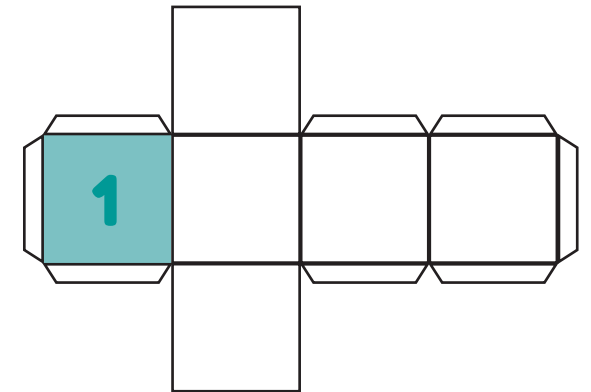


## A COLOURFUL PICNIC DAY!

1. Sol and Santiago are in the backyard.

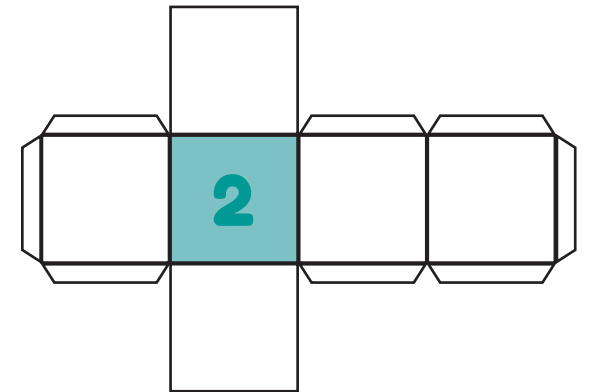
Santiago says: "I'm happy today!

It's a nice day for a picnic."





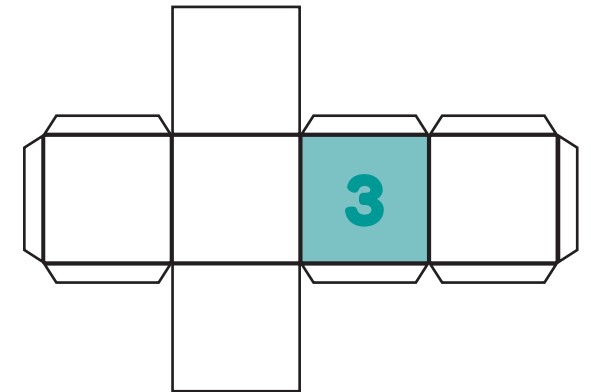
2. Sol says: "Let's sit on the grass. I'm tired." The grass is green.

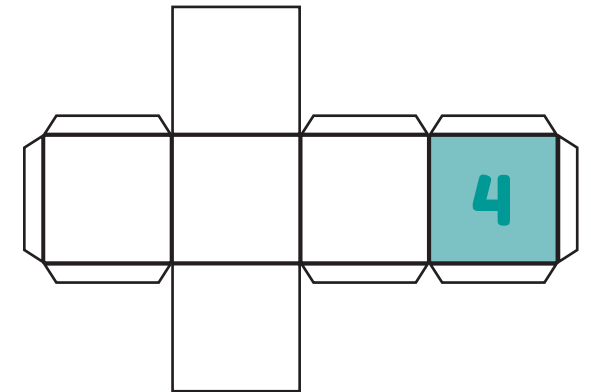
4. Sol opens the pencil case and says: "I've got scissors, a pencil and... crayons."

Santiago asks: "What colour are your crayons?"

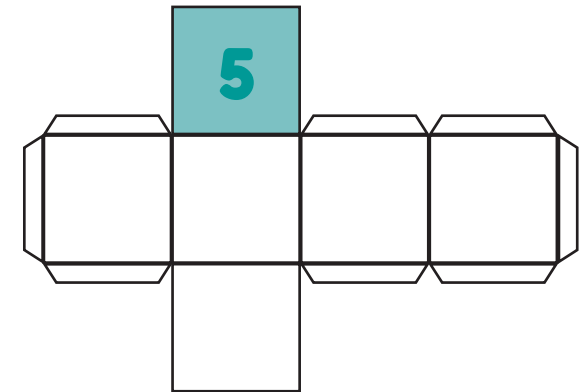
Sol says: "I've got a red crayon, a blue crayon, a green crayon and a yellow crayon!"

Sol answers: “It's... in the pencil case!”



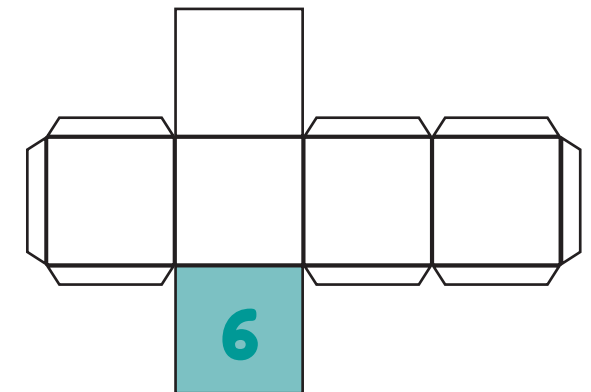


6. Santiago says: “Well Sol, I've got two sandwiches in the basket”

Santiago says: “Good idea! Let's pray first!”

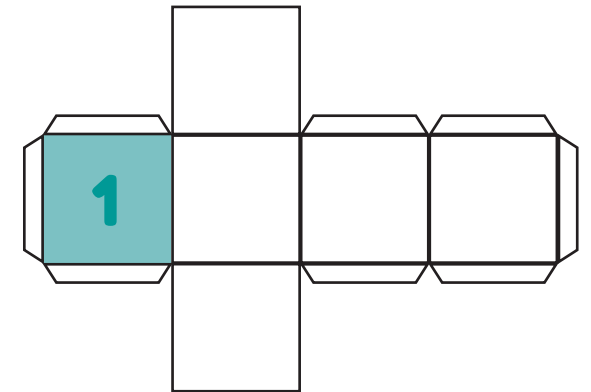
Sol prays: “Dear Jesus, thank you for the sandwiches. In Jesus' name, Amen.”

1. "Smile, Sol," Santiago says. He takes a funny picture of Sol in the kitchen.

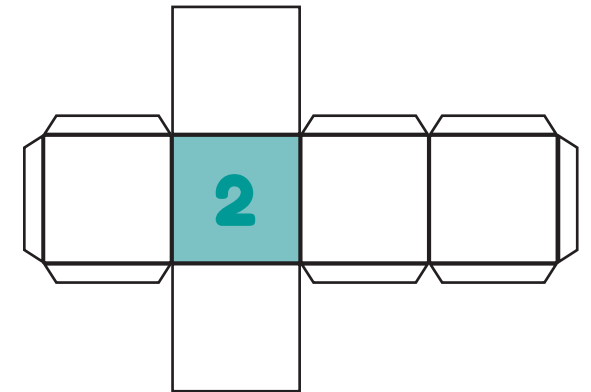




2. Sol says: "I'm very happy in my grandma's kitchen. I eat some delicious fruit."

Santiago says: "Really?, show me your favourite food."

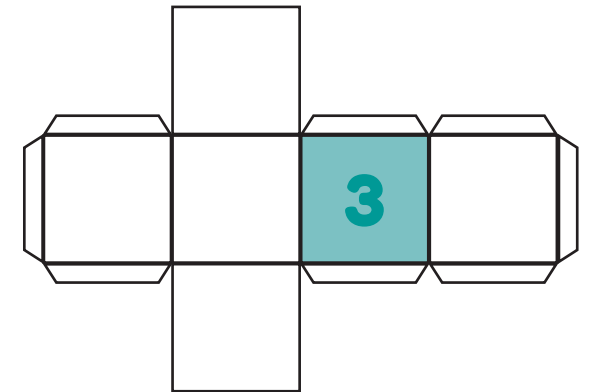
Sol says: "Come in Santiago, let's see."

This is a carrot. I love carrots.”

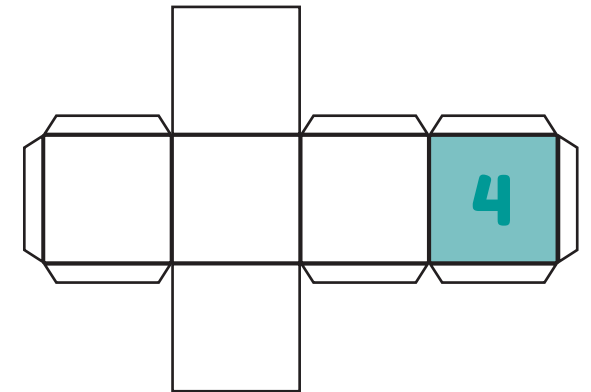




4. Sol says: "I love fruit and vegetables. Let's prepare orange juice."

Sol says: "Ok, let's put on an apron..."

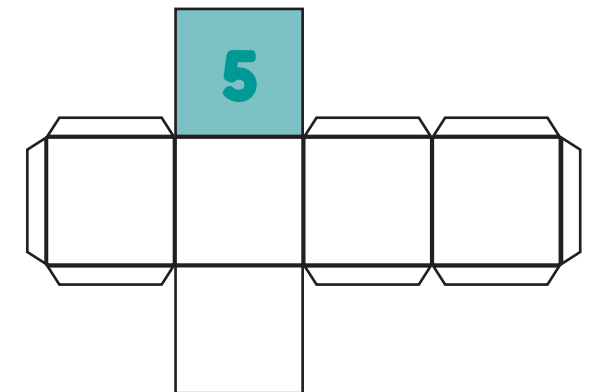

Sol says: “Let's count the oranges. One, two, three, four, five, six, seven and eight oranges.”



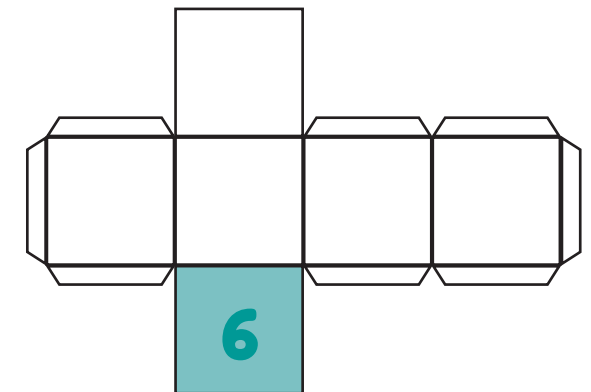


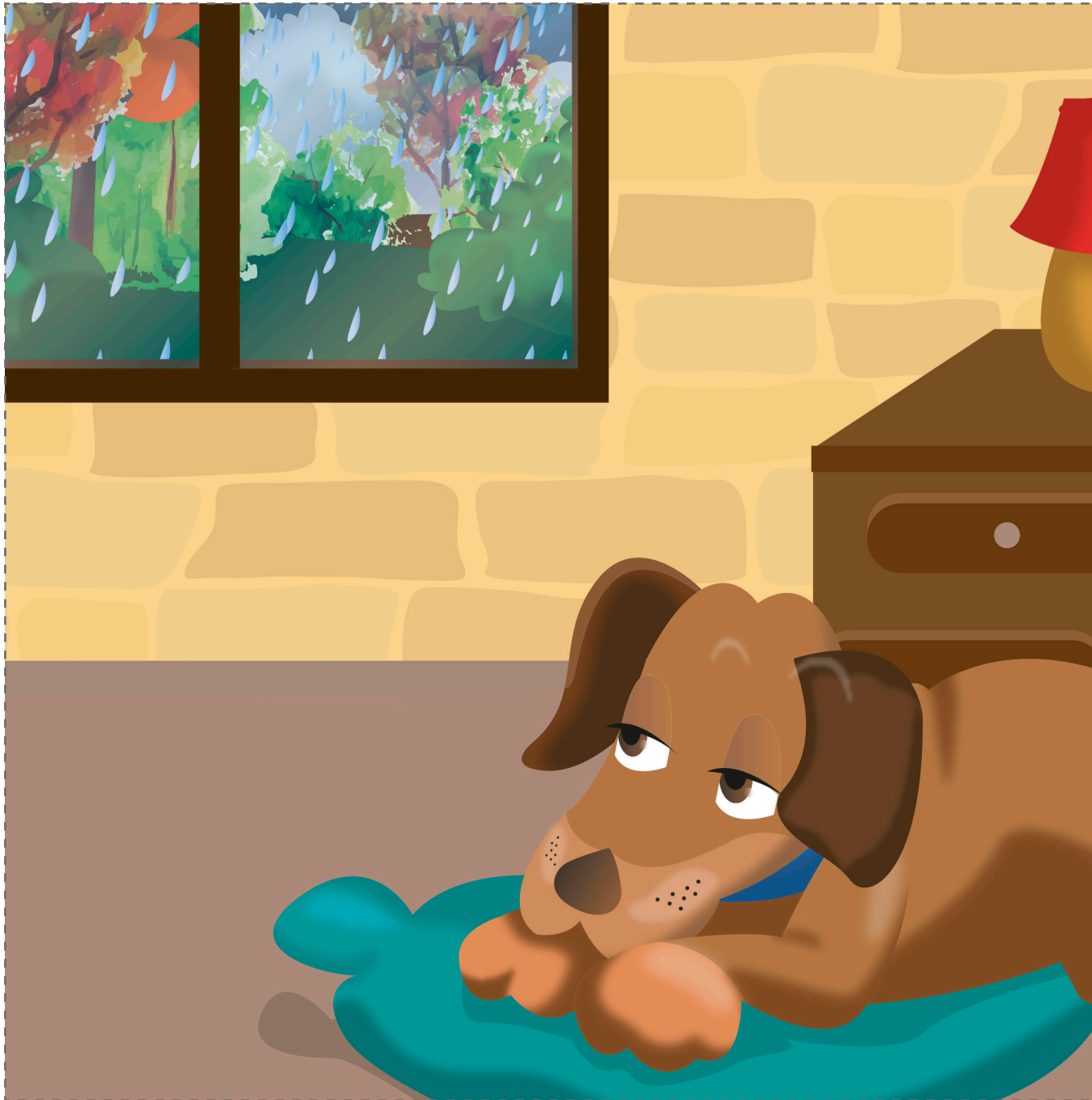
6. Sol and Santiago thanks Jesus for all the fruit.

Santiago says: "Mmmm, delicious!"

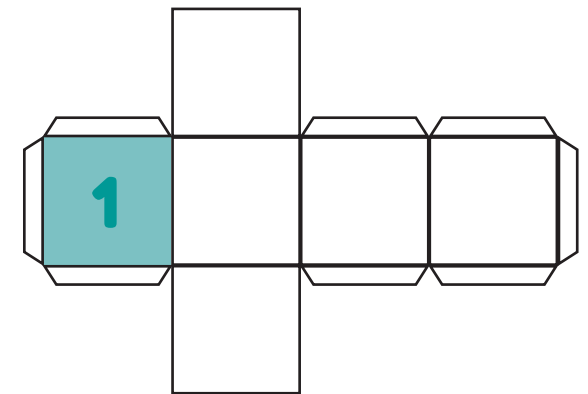
Sol says: "Thank you for your help, grandma!"





## SEASONS AND CINNAMON!

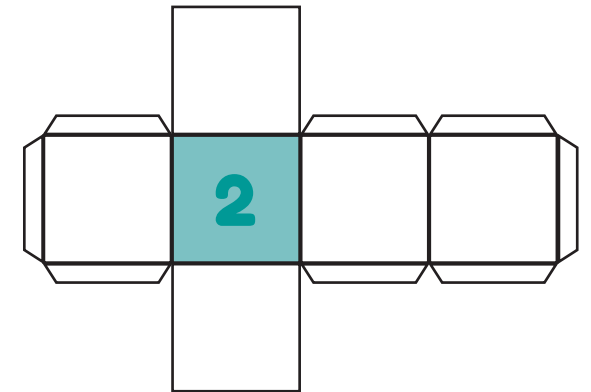

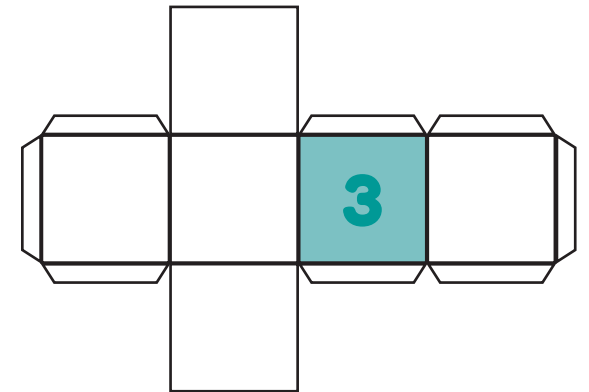


2. Cinnamon is drinking water. He's so thirsty... outside, the sun is shining strongly. It's hot and his eyes are big. It is SUMMER.



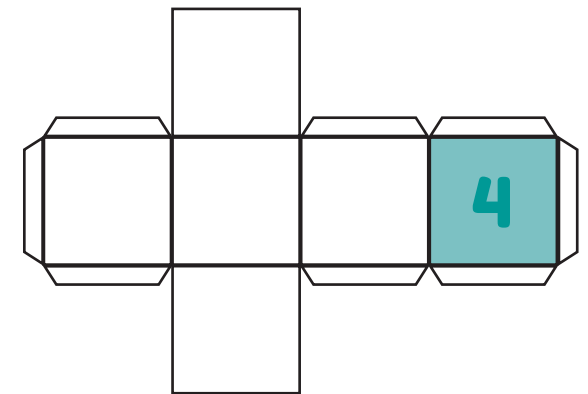


3. Cinnamon is eating hot tasty food. The wind is blowing and his ears are cool enough. Trees' leaves are falling down. It is AUTUMN.





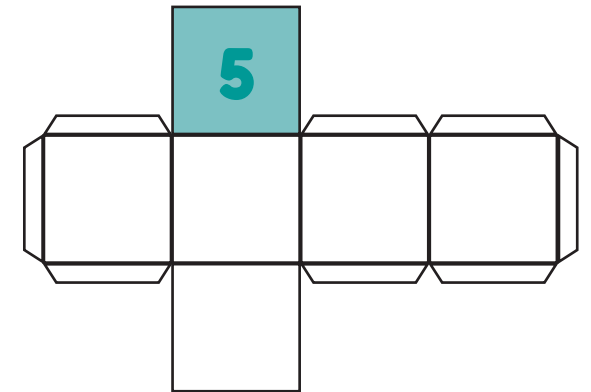
